Research excellence

Clinical research

- \$154.3 million
- 12,000+ total active participants enrolled in clinical research (identified individuals)
- 1,447 enrolled across all active clinical trials
- 400 faculty-led, VCU designed clinical studies
- 112 faculty-led VCU designed clinical trials
- 32 VCU held active drug / device registrations
- 5 VCU held new drug / device registrations
- 735 active clinical trials at VCU/VCUHS
- 1,197 clinical research studies

VCU commercialization efforts

- 111 invention disclosures
- 171 patents filed
- 20 patents issued
- 17 licenses to start-ups
- 8 new start-ups
- \$4.3 million licensing revenue
